SAFETY FIRST

Crew will work on rotating basis – with each crew member taking several breaks in our Cooling Station. We will have plenty of water, snacks, fruit, hose, ice, sun screen, etc.

Volunteers We need YOU



Volunteers must be able and willing to dig dirt, shovel gravel, move wheelbarrow of both. Other tasks include carrying buckets, cutting liners, holding things in place, etc.

In addition to the BIG DIG II tasks, we also like a couple folks to run a weed whip along the fence line on the River des Peres side.

Purpose and Scope of Project

To remedy the ongoing mud problem around Water Station 3, and the nearby sprinkler head (s) – we plan to expand and improve the gravel pool pad. A French drain will be installed in a 2 foot trench in two places along with appropriate materials and liners; the general pad area will be dug approximately 6 inches deep and filled with Meramec gravel. The existing rubber edging will be relocated along the fence line to keep the gravel from spilling through the fence. The existing concrete pad around the water station will be enlarged by using a border of aggregate stepping stones and the enlarged gravel pad surface will be topped off with a three prong aggregate stepping stone path and pavers as an exterior buffer. There will be plenty of surface space for multiple pools and room for an abundance of splashing and good times. \odot

The available dirt will be used in the lowest area where we have water constantly pooling from the sprinkler head. This area will also have a French drain in a 2 foot trench, appropriate materials, and topped with either sod or grass seed, tbd. If time and energy permit, and if we have remaining dirt – we may opt to fill in other low areas.

BIG DIG II Time Line

August 8 (Wed), 8:00pm - Close Water Station 3

August 8 (Wed), 8:00pm – Open temporary pool area in front corner of park, where the turf is strong enough to handle the water activity. A hose will be attached to the fence, as we did in previous seasons.

August 9 (Thurs), 8:00pm – Close back section of park with temporary fencing (across width of park)

August 10 (Fri), Afternoon/Evening – Supplies delivered

August 11 (Sat), 7:00am – Set up Crew Cooling Station, final supplies delivered.

August 11 (Sat), 8:00am – Begin work

August ? (TBD) – Temporary fencing will remain up and Water Station 3 closed until completion of the project. This may take anywhere from 3-4 days to two weeks. Once the sod or seed is installed, we will revert to a smaller temp fencing just around that particular area – and Water Station 3, Agility, and the back area of the park will re-open.

We need at least 10 people

Dig dirt, shovel gravel, move wheelbarrow of both. Carry buckets of gravel / other supplies. Measure, cut liners and piping, hold things in place, etc. Take down small area of our green fencing / put back up; Temp fencing. Move and arrange pavers and stepping stones.

If time permits: Run weed trimmer along fence line, River desPeres side; re-set stepping stones in gangway; clean up and extend Day Lily bed near Water Station 1-2; weed flower beds at front entrance.

Follow-up Crew: Anything not completed on August 11, will be done in the following two weeks, as members are available.

Deliver to dog park on Saturday – between 7:00-9:00 am

4-5 bags ice (20 lb bags) 5-6 cases bottled water * Gatorade, or other sports beverage Salted peanuts, other salty snacks Granola bars **Cookies (sturdy enough to withstand heat)** Watermelon Grapes, apples, other fruit

* Left over water is used for the ongoing volunteer projects, we always need bottled water

Be a Doggie Sitter

Only crew will be allowed behind the temporary fence

We need non-crew members to watch BIG DIG II crew dogs - they need supervision while their humans work on the project. You will be assigned specific dogs to "babysit".

Be a Donor

BIG DIG II will be funded from our general operating funds, just as BIG DIG I was funded. The difference is that we did not anticipate doing a BIG DIG II this season – so while we have the funds to do this project – it does increase operating expenses.
