Swim and Romp Play Date Saturday, September 20 8:30 – 10:30 am



Children under 8 years old – are not allowed inside the dog park – enforced by Park Rangers

Large fenced in dog park with pond. Plenty of room for doggie swimming and acres for romping.

Broemmelsiek Dog Park – They doubled the size – 4.50 acres of doggie fun. This is a **public** and **free dog park**; expect other 2 and 4 Leggeds to join us as the morning moves forward! There is a hose at the covered pavilion. Feel free to bring your lawn chair or beach towels, if you wish to sit on the grass or closer to the pond or further into the open spaces, away from crowd. Parking at entry; restroom is on site.

Co-incidentally – St Charles Parks Department is holding their annual **Paws in the Park** on the same day: 10:00am to 2:00pm. Come for our Meet-Up – Stay for the doggie festival.

Call Broemmelsiek **Hot Line 636/949-7475** before heading out – park closes to protect the turf when the grounds are wet.

Directions to Broemmelsiek Dog Park

Schwede and Wilson Roads, off State Road DD. Take Highway 40/61, exit at the WingHaven Blvd (Highway DD) interchange – go south on Hwy DD for approximately 4 miles. Turn right on Schwede Road to the 2nd park entrance. Sign for "off leash" area at the 2nd entrance on the left. Follow signs to "off leash" area – Canine Drive. *About a 35 minute drive from our dog park*.

<u>Directions</u>: 1615 Schwede Road, Wentzville, MO 63385 (off of Highway DD/Winghaven Blvd). Go west on Hwy 64/40, take exit DD / Winghaven; turn left on DD; go approximately 4 miles; turn right on Schwede Road. Use second park entrance on left.

Admission: Free. No admission fee but this event is a fundraiser and it is suggested that you donate dog food (*no size requirements*) in exchange for tickets to play the games. There are prizes for the contests and the games. All net proceeds benefit St. Charles County Pet Adoption Center and Five Acres Animal Shelter. **Stop by booth at entry to sign event waiver**
