





Organizational Structure

- ➤ The SW City Dog Park Board and Committees are made up of volunteers. Volunteers do this on top of their normal jobs and family activities. They are not paid and they work on the park during our free time.
- > The Board and Committees meet monthly to discuss current issues with the park.
 - Additional monthly meetings with the Southampton Neighborhood Association (SNA) Executive Board and bi-monthly general SNA membership meetings.
- ➤ All financials are incorporated into the SNA accounts and taxes are filed as 501(c)4. SNA is responsible for all tax filings.

Dog Park Milestones

- ➤ May 2005 Board of Alderman passes ordinance allowing fenced off-leash dog play areas
- ➤ November 2005 Southampton Neighborhood Association agrees to sponsor SW City Dog Park Committee
- ➤ May June 2006 Fundraising activities including Pet Photo Contest, Garage Sale, Trivia Night with Stray Rescue
- > September 2006 Dog Park officially opens
- December 2008 Expansion of Park
- ➤ April 2010 Sprinkler system installed



Issues / Rules



- Continued Issues with Non-Member Access
 - Risks: No evidence that the dog is vaccinated, traceability if incident occurs, and insurance requirements.
- Aggressive behavior (members & dogs)
 - Respect others' wishes in terms of dog interaction!
 - Report issues to Incident Review Committee they need dog's name & tags numbers involved in issue, description of incident, any witnesses. Based on the severity of the incident and history of dogs/owners an action plan will be presented to the Board for consideration and action.
 - If no one reports it, Committee and Board can not respond.

Groundskeeping

- Ordinance 66595 requires that the dog park surface be either stone dust or grass, and that "If grass, it must be irrigated and reseeded in the fall and spring understanding that some of the area will have to be cordoned off during the reseeding process."
- o In the April / May timeframe we will be closing the park for 5-6 weeks for ground maintenance
 - Ornamental grass (Pampas, etc) will be scattered to encourage dogs & people to move around the park, also reduce "line of sight" aggressive behavior between dogs.
 - Installation of 2 water fountains

Events

- Yappy Hour during spring closure events for 2 legged only and/or with dogs (dependant upon
- New Member Training (Sept/Oct)

Opportunities to Help / Committees



- Incident Review Committee handle and address issues / incidents between members & their dogs
- <u>Landscaping / Maintenance</u> oversee maintenance needs, including trash pick-up
- Social / Events organize future events at the park and membership activities, fundraising if project identified beyond current financial abilities
- Mailings / Newsletter organize and design mailings/newsletters for the membership
- Web Developer make necessary changes to the website
