

Member Registration Process

Manual Steps

- 1. Pick up from PO
- 2. Open mail review paperwork
- If previous member, search database info, make sure current info/changes added to database
- 4. Save and Print Envelope
- 5. Dog Info Add new dog if necessary
- 6. Type key from Owner Info
- 7. Update info on dogs
- 8. Add dog picture photo name if there is a photo
- 9. If new member, add to database
- 10. Save and Print Envelope
- 11. Dog Info Type key from Owner Info
- 12. Type dog info on each dog
- 13. Need to add info key for each dog
- 14. Add dog picture photo name if there is a photo
- 15. Record tag number for each dog or application

- 16. Put tags and o-ring in tag envelope
- 17. Put letter and tag envelope in envelope that matches application name
- 18. Make sure their picture appears on form
- 19. Add stampsif 4 tags there needs to be 2 stamps orbetter is 2 envelopes
- 20. Go back to database and put tag number for corresponding dog
- 21. Scan pictures
- 22. Name pictures with last name of owner and dog name
- 23. Open with paint and resize and crop
- 24. When all scanned pictures are complete add to dog pictures folder
- 25. Go to each dog applicant and make File Application
- 26. Mail envelopes






