Finance Reports 8:00

- SWCDP is a 501 (c) 3 federal income tax exempt charitable organization in the eyes of the IRS.
- Annual return is due by May 15th of following year.
- Organizations with less than \$50,000 in revenue allowed to "e-file" form 990-N; also referred to as an e-postcard filing.
- Organizations with over \$50,000 in revenue have more extensive reporting requirements.
- This is an information filing only to make sure organization is still active/a going concern.
- Return has been filed already for 2012 tax year.


Annual Audit

- Audit can be volunteered; not necessarily a charge for it.


