

- Sales Tax Exempt 2013 approved by MO Dept of Revenue; annual "good standing filing"

- Insurance Policy General liability includes StL City per Ordinance 66595
- Money Market Status \$11,600 balance; Interest rate .27 %
- Money Market Purpose
 - Create savings separate from operating funds for special projects
 - Be own funding source no borrowing




